



Assistance for AFT + Program Participants Impacted by Hurricane Isaac

Union members living in areas impacted by Hurricane Isaac, and who participate in AFT + programs, provided by Union Plus, may be eligible for financial assistance.

Union Plus Disaster Relief Grants of \$500 are available to help participants in the AFT + Credit Card or Mortgage programs that are facing financial hardship due to Hurricane Isaac.

To qualify for a Disaster Relief Grant, the union member must:

1. Have been a victim of a FEMA-declared natural disaster or emergency in counties designated as qualifying for **FEMA individual assistance**.
2. Have experienced a significant loss of income or property within the last six months due to the disaster.
3. Have had an AFT + Credit Card or an AFT + Plus Mortgage for at least 12 months with the account in good standing (up-to-date on payments).
4. Provide acceptable proof of property or income loss.
