HB 653	Bagley, Larry (R)	Requires an evaluator of a teacher or administrator to conduct a post-observation conference with the teacher or administrator after a classroom visit to provide input including but not limited to commendation and recommendations for improvement.	House Education	Filed
HB 892	James, Ted (D)	Modify teacher laws. Restore three year probationary period. Remove "Highly Effective" rating as the threshold for tenure. (See digest for additional modifications)	House Education	Filed

SB 342	Boudreaux, Gerald (D)	Provides relative to the use of student growth data in teacher evaluations. Provides for a professional employee evaluation program that uses multiple measures of student achievement, which includes a value-added assessment model as determined by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BSESE)	Senate Education	Filed
SB 308	Milkovich, John (D)	Limits the amount of instructional time devoted to state assessments and district testing administered at each individual grade level to no more than two percent of the total required instructional minutes established for the school year.	Senate Education	Filed
